Field trials

- Procurement of materials (seed, sampling materials, fertiliser, chemical etc)

- Monitor trials, conduct in-field measurements, record and collate data
- Chemical handling & application
- Assist contractors with seeding, spray & harvest operations
- Laboratory work including the processing of soil and crop samples & grain quality analysis
