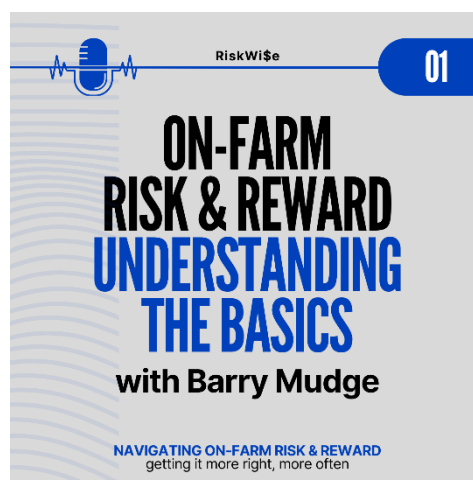
"These discussions are the key to helping farmers challenge their perspectives and improve decision-making outcomes," she added.
