NITROGEN - ACHIEVE YOUR YIELD POTENTIAL

The latest episode of the GRDC-funded RiskWi\$e podcast focuses on one of the biggest agronomic decisions facing grain growers—nitrogen management.

The series has been designed to offer practical tools and insights to help listeners become more confident when assessing risk and reward, and when making on-farm decisions.

The ultimate aim is to help Aussie grain growers get it more right, more often.

In Episode 5, Hart Field-Site Group's research & extension manager, Rebekah Allen, shares findings from local field trials, including nitrogen carryover and N-banking, and reveals current practices across SA's Mid North.

She also talks about seasonal variability and explains how a "profit by deciles" tool can support nitrogen strategies under changing seasonal conditions.

"This conversation with Bek reminds us that at the end of the day, it's about balancing nutrient supply, managing costs, and understanding rainfall risks," said podcast cohost and Hart executive officer, Sandy Kimber.

"Every farm business is different and Bek offers practical tools that allow flexibility in our approach by understanding possible outcomes and then balancing that with our personal appetite for risk."
